In preparation for the lifting of restrictions (hopefully on the 19th of July), we are setting up our schedule of classes and clubs.

Classes

Our classes will be led by our experienced painters who will be able to help you learn the basics of drawing, watercolour, acrylic, or oil painting. The cost will be £4 for a two-hour session, with all materials supplied. There will be a limit of 12 people per session.

Clubs

The clubs will be of interest to people who prefer to do 'their own thing', using their own materials. The cost for these will be £3 for a two-hour session (again with a limit of 12 people). If there is a need to use communal materials, they are available, and we ask that a £1 donation is made to cover the cost.
