We have now established and consolidated our fine arts activities (drawing, watercolours, acrylics & oil classes and clubs) at Front Street and our craft, children's and pastel groups at Gibson Street). So, it is time to introduce other art and craft activities and then other arts (such as literary, performing and culinary arts) to meet the needs of our community.

We are starting with the 'Photography for Beginners' sessions with Kevin and, once we have the new flooring installed at Gibson Street, we will be looking at printing and sculpture activities.

As well as providing these additional activities to our community, we will be increasing the utilisation of Gibson Street, ensuring the viability of our Community Centre, and building up to the Newbiggin Arts Festival in 2023.



At the last committee meeting (held on the 28th February), we found out that we now have 179 people on our database, with 120 of them acting members! This is great news as it means we are continuing to grow and provide a much needed and appreciated service to our community.
