### LEGAL STUFF

- Newbiggin Arts Centre is a charity
- Charitable Incorporated Organisation with voting Members other than its charity trustees – 'Association' model \*
- <u>Not</u> 'Foundation' model, whose only voting members are the charity trustees themselves
- Incorporated on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2015 as "Little Gem Art & Craft Gallery"
- On 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020 officially changed name to "Newbiggin Arts Centre" following vote at Trustees meeting on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2020
- Requires an annual AGM
- Excused in 2020 because of COVID restrictions

## © Newbiggin Arts Centre SEMI-LEGAL STUFF

- Because NAC is 'Association' model \* only Trustees and Members should attend & be able to vote at AGM
- But we don't have any formal Members (other than Trustees)
- For transparency, we have invited all 'associate' members (you!)
  - but no formal voting rights

- Trustees intend to implement a formal Membership (with annual/monthly membership fees), giving Members a right to access and use all our facilities and to vote at AGM

### RETIREMENT AND RE-ELECTION OF TRUSTEES

### Constitution

13. Appointment of charity trustees

(2) At every annual general meeting of the members of the CIO, one-third of the charity trustees shall retire from office.

#### 16. Reappointment of charity trustees

Any person who retires as a charity trustee by rotation ..... is eligible for reappointment. A charity trustee who has served for three consecutive terms may not be reappointed for a fourth consecutive term, but may be reappointed after an interval of at least three years.
