Chair's Report

We've come a long way over the past four years...

Significant introduction of new workshops and courses in 2024!

8 new tutors
28 new courses
148 sessions
792 participants
134 members

- Major challenge when Ted left at end of July
 - 50 members went down to 20
- In 2025 99 active members, averaging 109 participations per week (+10 children)

Retirement & Re-election of Trustees

Constitution

- 13. Appointment of charity trustees
- (2) At every annual general meeting of the members of the CIO, one-third of the charity trustees shall retire from office.
- 16. Reappointment of charity trustees

Any person who retires as a charity trustee by rotation is eligible for reappointment.

A charity trustee who has served for three consecutive terms may not be reappointed for a fourth consecutive term, but may be reappointed after an interval of at least three years.
