3.	Matters arising	 Gibson Street – Window repair, the window will be repaired on Monday 25.11.24. This will be replaced in 2 pieces due to the size Front Street Building Frontage – it has been agreed this will be repaired by Leon who will run this as a workshop with 4 helpers. The cost of the repair will be approx. £1500. This does not include the cost of the paint which we are hoping to get free of charge from Akzo Nobel. It was agreed at the time that the colour of the new shop front would be pale blue to match the Logo. This has since been rejected by the landlord. 	sw
		 Grant for Fire Extinguishers - these have now been purchased and installed. These will stand on the floor but have been secured to the walls as the walls were not sturdy enough to hold the weight. There are two for Gibson Street and three for Front Street including a small extinguisher for the office area. We also have received the CCTV ordered which SW is going to install. Two inside the building and two outside. Advertising – we have had 2 adverts posted in the North Seaton Directory. One a general advert and one an editorial whole page.
