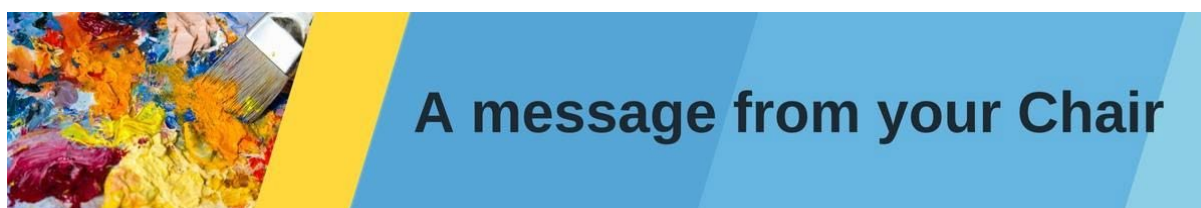




Sept 2023

Digital Art Class

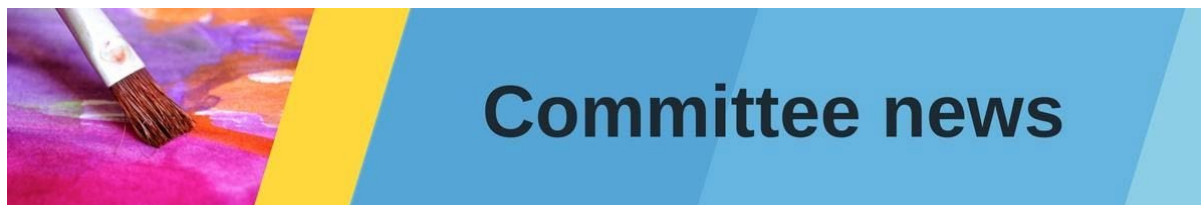
Starts Saturday 30 September

Wall plaque commission...

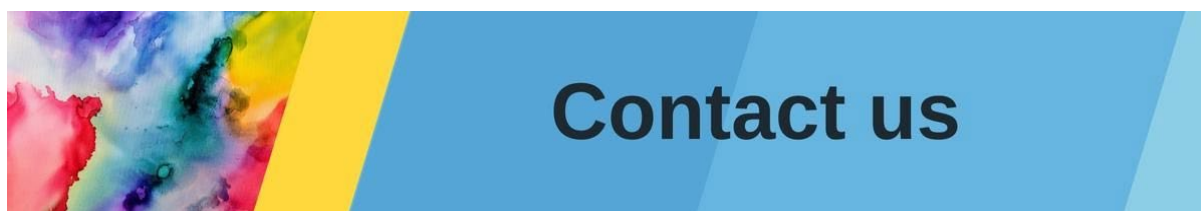
