The Arts for All classes begin on Wednesday, 11th September, from 1-3 at our Front St. studio. Our new tutor, Gary Simpson will be on hand to help/advise/guide everyone, whether you are a beginner or more experienced. Support will be tailored to meet the needs of individuals across all media (watercolour, acrylics, etc.) so it is a fantastic opportunity for all! A donation of £6 is requested, and all materials are supplied. So, don't be shy, come along and have some fun and learn something new!

We are expanding our photography course. As the six-week photography class with Ivor comes to an end, the existing class has asked that this programme is expanded (it's obviously been a success!). As a result, we are running additional sessions which has opened up the opportunity for those who weren't able to attend originally but are still interested. If you are, please let Wendy know.

How does coming along to one of our clubs where you can paint what you want with others sound? We have spaces available on Monday and Friday afternoons from 1-3 and Friday mornings from 9-11 held at our Front St. studio. The Children's Art Group is back up and running again on Friday evenings, from 6:30-8:00 in our Gibson St. studio. Cost are £2 with all materials supplied.

Our (WHAT) volunteer programme is changing...

Our volunteers make up a small but mighty team of people who get great pleasure in helping to run and develop NAC and provide a valued service to the community. In addition to the work we do behind the scenes, we like to have fun too! We have volunteer events where we get together to discuss things, learn things, and enjoy a bite to eat and a drink (or two!).

However, with all the changes we are undergoing, what with new classes, workshops, and the recent addition of Wendy, our Administration Officer, what we need from our volunteers has changed.

We have identified three key roles that we need to fill. If you are already a volunteer with us, or if you aren't currently a volunteer with us but think one (or all!) of the roles sound like something you'd like to do, please let us know—we'd love to have your join our team.

The following are the three main roles we need to fill:

1) Tutor Support

This role involves taking responsibility for opening and closing the studio, taking attendance and cash and/or card payments. For ongoing classes, it requires a commitment to attend all sessions with the understanding that if there is a reason you can't attend, you would inform Wendy who will find a substitute. This is a great opportunity to not only meet new people, but attend the sessions for free!

2) Weekend Cover

In this role you can either be a 'keyholder' who is responsible for opening and closing the studio and taking payments (card only) if there are any sales, or you could cover a period of time in between opening and closing. The hours are flexible and based on your availability. All we ask is that you let Wendy know when you are available.

3) Events Support

We have a few regularly scheduled events through the year where we need people to help set up, e.g. tables, gazebo, etc., serve refreshments, greet visitors, etc. We are also planning on increasing the number and location of events in the coming months, and thereby, are looking to create a pool of people who would like to help out, on a one-off basis.

We currently have a 'hanging' team who are responsible for organising and displaying our art exhibitions. While we are operating with a full team at this time, if this is something you might be interested, please let us know and we can call on you as needed.

If you are listed as a member of our volunteer team but not interested/available to help out in one of these roles, don't worry, we won't remove you from our list unless you request us to. We will keep you in 'reserve' so we can contact you as required.

What's next? We will be sending an email to our current team of volunteers to see if anyone is interested in taking on one or more of these roles (if they haven't already) and invite any of our other members to express their interest by emailing Wendy (info@newbigginartscentre.org).
